Seasonal Employment Fact Sheet

WHO?

Our seasonal work force is mainly comprised of high school and college students (75%), senior citizens, school teachers and housewives. However, we encourage anyone who wants to have fun, make new friends and earn up to \$7 an hour to apply.

HOW MANY?

Before the summer is over, we plan to hire approximately 3,500 seasonal workers.

WHAT JOBS?

Full- and part-time seasonal positions are available in ride operations, merchandise, food service, games and attractions, security, safari and a variety of other departments.

EXPERIENCE?

Most seasonal positions require no experience.

AGE?

The minimum age for working at the park is 16. Ride operators and security personnel must be at least 18 years old.

WAGES?

Salaries vary according to the hours an employee works. The hourly rate for working the day shift is \$5.05. The rate for working until closing is \$6. The rate for working the overnight shift is \$7.

BENEFITS?

Seasonal employees can take advantage of flexible work hours, advancement opportunities, free family passes to the park, transportation to and from the park from selected areas for a nominal fee, after-work activities, exclusive ride time, park merchandise discounts, cookouts and cast parties, and more.

* SFGA is the largest seasonal employer in the state.

* Approximately 60% of our current seasonal staff are "rehires" from 1994.
